



James Zamora

James Zamora is an American artist known for his photorealistic “aisle paintings”. Using different spatial compositions, the artist translates common marketplace imagery into a stylized, elevated environment. Through Zamora's work, he explores the particularity between the relationship of our eyes with the subtleties of our immediate reaction. His paintings investigate current trends and their effects on the consumer.



Zamora says of his art, “As a realist painter, I am attracted to the technical complexities of everyday life.” As a first generation Mexican American, grocery store aisles were exciting because of the abundance of food provided a sense of security for me. This is something my Mexican parents did not have access to in their native home. My paintings represent the positive associations of packaged food such as domestic familiarity.

Zamora earned his BFA in painting and drawing from The University of North Texas in 2010, then an MFA in painting from Texas Woman's University in 2015. His work is exhibited nationally on a regular basis and is in numerous personal and public collections.

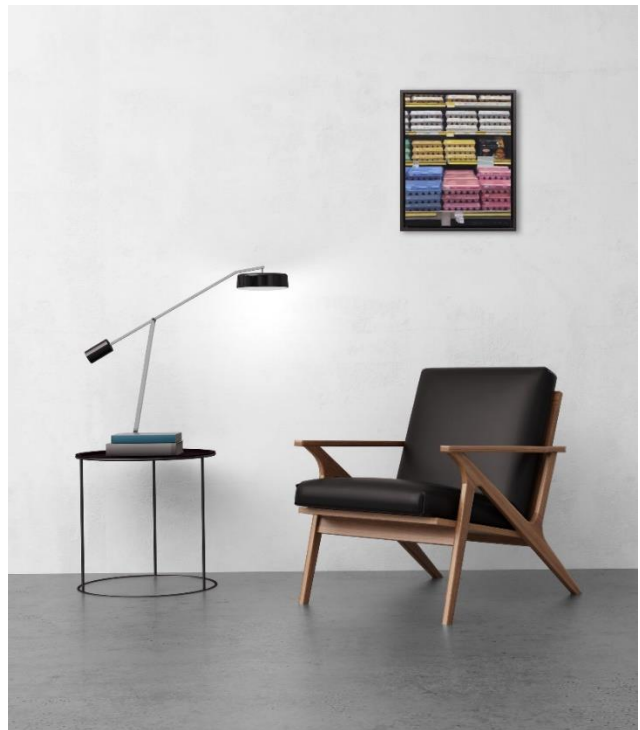
